

PAINT TO USE:

- Crayola "Washable" paint
- Crayola "Washable Tempera"
- Crayola "Tempera" paint This works, but it's twice as expensive as the other two options

(Most other brands of Tempera or Washable paint don't stick to the mural board at all--they just bead up. These Crayola types stick to the board and wipe off easily.)

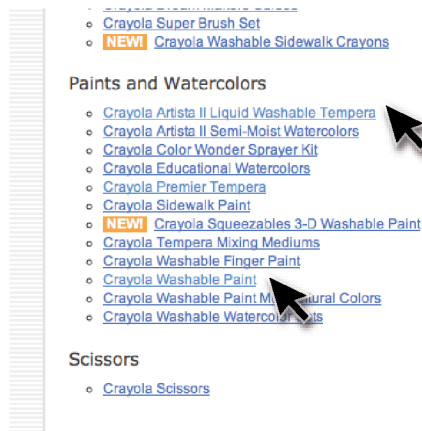
DO NOT USE:

- Acrylic paints
- Gluache paints
- Watercolors
- Latex (house paint)
- Any oil-based paints
- Alkyd paints
- Oil pastels
- Crayons

Where to get it:

Many sites sell this paint, but we recommend Blick Art Supplies online. You can type in the link below, or you can type in "Blick Crayola" into a Google search, and the first listing should be:

Note: "Washable" and "Washable Tempera" are very similar. "Washable" might be slightly more, well, washable, but it's slightly more expensive.

Colors to get:

Red
Orange
Yellow
Green
Blue
Violet
Brown
Magenta
Peach
Turquoise
(DO NOT get Black or White)*

Colors to mix:

You can easily add several colors, just by buying a bunch of extra white, and adding some of the other colors to it. You can do it very easily there on-site, just in a plastic cup.

Pink--mix 1/5 red with 4/5 white.
Light Green--mix 1/3 green with 2/3 white
Light Gray--mix 1/15 black with 14/15 white
Dark Gray--mix 1/10 black with 9/10 white
Different skin tones--mix 1/5 brown with 4/5 white

*Only buy black or white if you intend to mix any of these colors. Note that you need almost a full bottle of white for each color you want to mix.
